Payroll

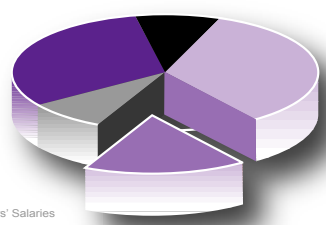
Quickly and conveniently process your business payroll and produce all the necessary reports and documentation for the Inland Revenue.

The payroll section of the system has the capacity to store an extensive amount of information about each of your employees - from basic contact information and bank details to training courses attended and emergency medical information. Its primary role though is to help you calculate your weekly or monthly payroll, whilst taking into consideration the necessary tax rates and expenses.

An analysis of each employee's pay and deductions is available to view on the system in the form of a P11. Different Pay Periods such as weekly, two weekly and monthly can all be handled with ease. The system will print payslips and reports giving all the information you need to manage and record information about your Payroll. This includes a facility to consider and record all types of expenses.

You can select to pay employees either by cash, cheque or BACS. All information entered into or calculated within payroll, is accessible via the extensive reporting functions included within Enterprise. Different types of pay such as commission, overtime and bonuses are all brought together to calculate the gross amount payable. When the payroll is run the system will calculate income tax and national insurance deductions. It will also calculate statutory sick pay, maternity pay, paternity pay and adoption pay as well as any other statutory deductions such as student loan payments, attachment to earnings orders and pension payments.

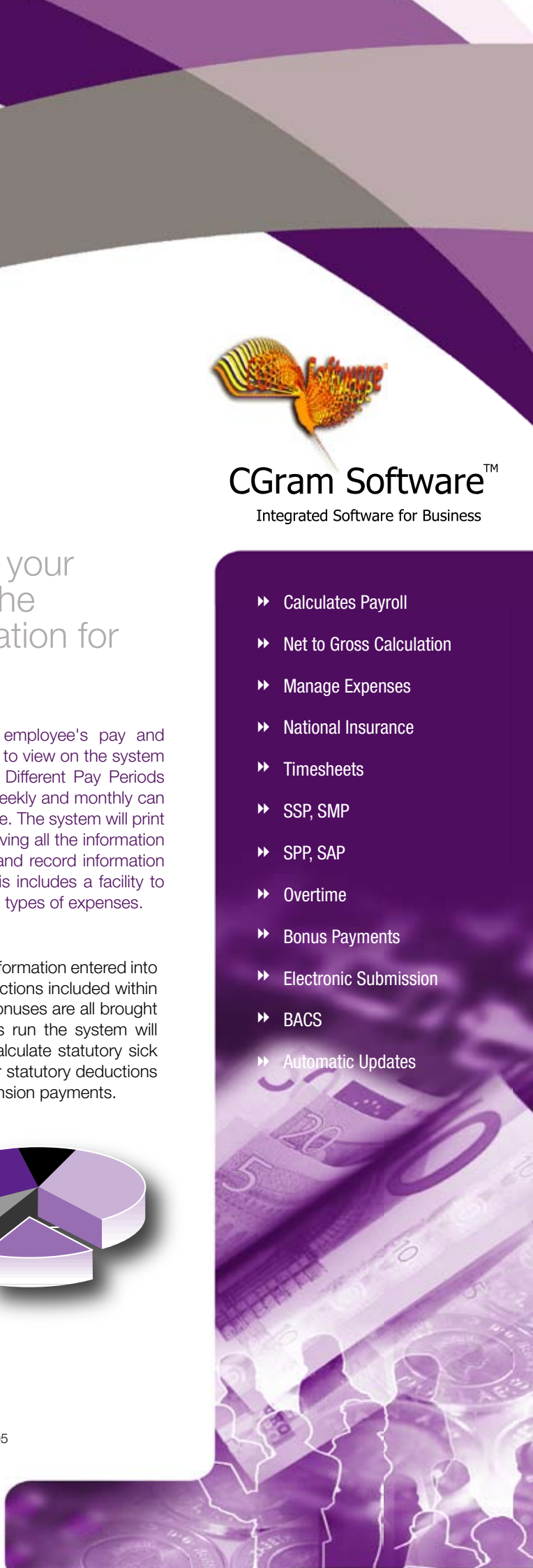
For each employee there is a calendar showing holidays taken, sickness absence and days worked either onsite or off site. All your end of year returns (P14/P60/P35) may also be printed or transmitted electronically to the Inland Revenue. As you'd expect, the payroll facilities within Enterprise are also flexible enough to handle changes to government rates, limits and allowances. 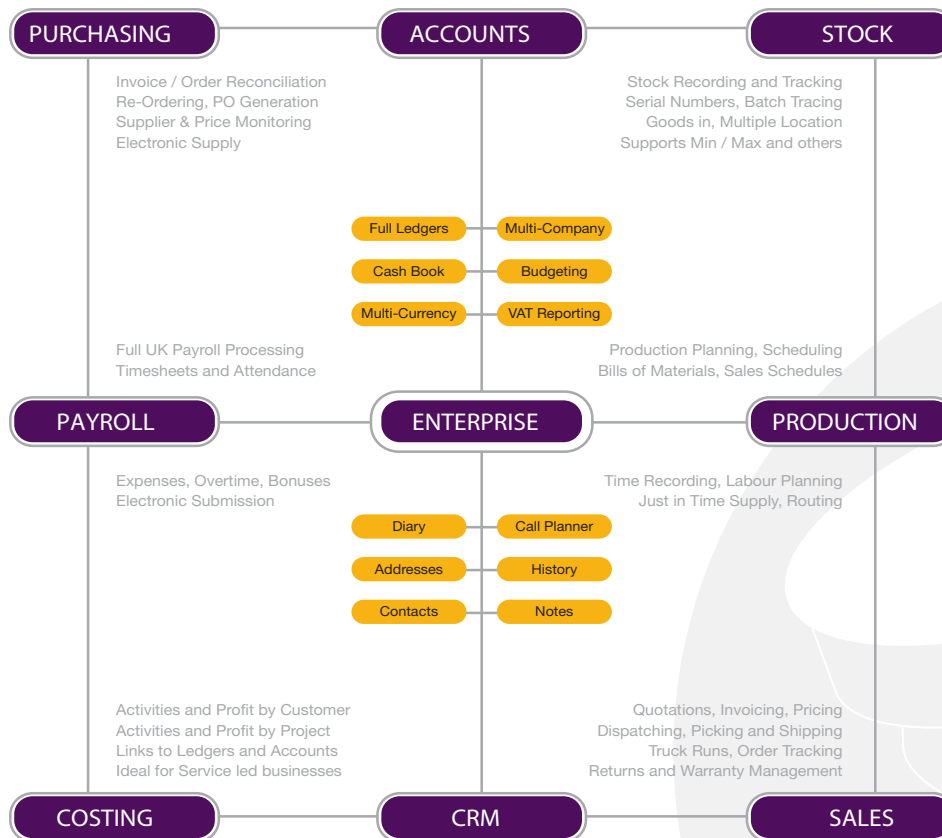
